- 2. Communicate the Need: Individuals throughout your organization need to understand the reason behind the goals that are set. Communicating the what and why to members throughout your organization is vital because it builds unity and strengthens your organization's commitment to the military spouse community.
- 3. Develop an Action Plan: Writing a plan to help implement your goals will help you identify manageable steps to track your progress.
 Consider expanding your goals by creating actions items that allow you to see your accomplishments and celebrate your wins.

Setting goals is important to maintain focus throughout the year. No goal is too big or too small! Hosting a military spouse fellow, facilitating a hiring event, attending MSEP webinars and increasing spouse hiring numbers are all goals with a measurable impact and contribute toward your organization's engagement.
